Calling All Candidates

Any Rye resident interested in being a candidate for election to the Rye City School District Board of Education may pick up a candidate's packet at the District's Central Administration Offices, 411 Theodore Fremd Avenue, 100S, school days between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Eligible candidates are those who are qualified voters in the Rye City School District who will have lived in the Rye City School District for at least one year by the date of the election, May 15, 2012. A qualified voter is at least 18 years of age and is a United States Citizen.

Nomination to candidacy must be made by the submission of petitions which include the names of 100 qualified voters in the Rye City School District. Petitions must be submitted no later than April 25th at 5:00 p.m. Blank petitions are included in candidate packets.

On the seven-member Board there are three seats up for election this year. The three Board of Education members whose terms conclude June 30th are eligible to run for re-election. The three candidates who receive the greatest number of votes will be elected to office. The term of office is for three years and begins July 1, 2012.
