February 7th Board of Education Meeting

The Rye City School District Board of Education will hold a regular meeting Tuesday, February 7th, 2006 beginning at 8 p.m. in the Rye Middle School Multipurpose Room. The Board will meet in executive session beginning at 7 p.m. for the discussion of the employment history of current employees and the discussion of negotiations.

On the agenda is expected Board action to approve the U.S. History and Government 11RH curriculum, an agreement appointing counsel for construction, a letter of agreement with the architect on Milton School gym and parking lot design, election and Board of Registration resolutions for the May 16<sup>th</sup> Board of Education election and budget vote, budget transfers, personnel and Special Education items, and monthly financial reports. A presentation is scheduled on a Special Education program assessment and Dr. Daniel McCann, Deputy Superintendent, will present the annual testing and assessment update.

Members of the public are invited and encouraged to attend this meeting of the Board and to speak at designated times. The first fifteen minutes of the meeting are dedicated to a hearing of the public on non-agenda items.
