The Board of Education began a Facilities Tour of Milton Elementary School at 7:00 p.m. prior to the meeting at the Rye Middle School.

The meeting was called to order by Laura Slack at 7:25 p.m. on October 8, 2013 at Rye Middle School.

On a motion by Mr. Repetto, seconded by Ms. Pasquale and carried unanimously (7 -0) it was voted to move immediately into executive session to review the employment history of current and prospective employees, discuss negotiations pursuant to the Taylor Law and review current litigation.

On a motion by Ms. Glassberg, seconded by Ms. Belanger and carried unanimously (7 -0) it was voted at 8:10 p.m. to reconvene in public. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT**

Superintendent of Schools Dr. Frank Alvarez provided a report to the Board and to the community, first addressing the State Assessment results that were recently mailed home. He acknowledged that, as predicted, scores were lower than in previous years as these are new, longer, more difficult tests. Dr. Alvarez explained that Rye still outperformed many of its peer districts and continues to fare well among similar high performing districts. Assistant

Superintendent for Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment Dr. Betty Ann Wyks then explained that Academic Intervention Services (AIS) benchmarks, which are provided in tiers, are set individually by grade and subject. A more detailed report on the test results will be presented at the November 12 Board of Education meeting.

Dr. Alvarez shared news from around the District, announcing that the Parson Street Players will present *You Can't Take it With You* as their first play of the season this weekend on October 11 and 12. He also acknowledged a number of academic achievements earned by Rye High School students, who will be further congratulated at the October 22 Board of Education meeting. Many athletic accomplishments have taken place as well this season, and Dr. Alvarez explained that several teams are currently undefeated.

### **Presentation of the External Audit for the Fiscal Year that ended June 30, 2013**

Mr. Chris Kopf of O'Connor Davies accounting firm provided a Presentation of the External Audit for the Fiscal Year that ended June 30, 2013. The Rye City School District received an unqualified opinion, which is the highest level of insurance a firm can present.

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### **2013-2014 Student Enrollment**

Dr. Alvarez provided a detailed breakdown of the actual 2013-14 Student Enrollment as compared with the projected enrollment. The current enrollment of 3,303 exceeds the projected number by 93 students. This increase resulted in the addition of four classroom teachers, increase in related-arts time, and increase in instructional expenses. Additionally, the originally planned reduction of four class sections was not possible due to the higher-than-anticipated actual enrollment. (Attachment # IV)

Ms. Slack asked if anyone from the community wanted to comment on the enrollment report. There were no communications from the public.

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**Parent Request for Board of Education Special Education Committee (Attachment # V)**

The Board of Education and Dr. Alvarez discussed a parent request for a Board of Education Special Education Committee. Dr. Alvarez recommended the creation of a Superintendent's Special Education Advisory Committee, comprised of representatives from all five schools as well as District administrators. There was Board consensus to move forward with the idea. Mr. David Harris addressed the Board on the committee. He is the Midland representative to an organization RAISE (Rye All Inclusive Special Education) that is an outgrowth of SEPTA (Special Education Parent Teacher Association). Mr. Harris noted that he is looking forward to increased communication among the committee members.

On a motion by Mr. Fox, seconded by Ms. Pasquale and carried unanimously (7-0) it was voted at 12:07 a.m. to adjourn the meeting.
