**EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS**

The District recognizes that education is a continuous process that cannot be satisfactorily achieved without the coordination and cooperation of all components of the entire system. To achieve the highest quality of education on all levels, a critical appraisal of the program as it operates in each school and at each level is essential.

The purposes of evaluation of instructional programs are to:

1. identify instructional program strengths and weaknesses and inform future instructional program opportunities;
2. show the relationship between achievement and the District's stated goals;
3. examine the alignment of the instructional program with community expectations and State requirements; and
4. provide data for mandatory State reporting and public information.

The Superintendent is responsible for the evaluation of the District's instructional programs and will determine the process for such assessments in consultation with the Board. Academic progress based on test results, on-going curriculum review and an annual goal-setting agenda to address needs will be part of the District's evaluation of its instructional programs.

The Administration shall report to the Board, periodically, stating the results of such evaluations.
