USE OF AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS

The Rye City School District recognizes the requirement of making automatic external defibrillators (AED's) available in its buildings based upon the reported success of AED's in enhancing survival from incidents of sudden cardiac arrest.

Therefore, the use of AED's is authorized in the buildings of the Rye City School District pursuant to a collaborative agreement with an emergency health care provider in accordance with the Public Access Defibrillation Law (§3000-b, Public Health Law). A copy of the collaborative agreement shall be filed with the Department of Health and the appropriate regional council prior to use of the AED's.

The Superintendent, in consultation with the District Medical Director and the emergency health care provider, shall develop regulations and protocols governing the use of AED's within the District. These regulations and protocols shall be incorporated in the District's School Emergency Management Plan and shall be reviewed periodically by the District Medical Director and the emergency health care provider.
