TITLE I/PSEN/PCEN PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

The Board of Education, in order to have access to federal and state aid specifically intended to meet the needs of educationally deprived children, directs the Superintendent of Schools to ensure that the requirements for such aid are met and to ensure that application for such aid is made annually, when applicable, and that such application include but is not limited to the following:

TITLE I

1. description of annual assessment procedures;
2. a ranking of all eligible school attendance areas/buildings;
3. a description of the Title I project to be conducted, including a budget of proposed expenditures for services to public and private school children for the initial project year;
4. a description of the desired outcomes for participating children, including how the District will measure substantial progress toward meeting the desired outcomes;
5. a description of the services to be provided to eligible children enrolled in private schools and for children in local institutions for neglected or delinquent children;
66. a description of any innovation projects the District proposes to conduct;
7. data showing that the District has implemented reasonable fiscal control and fund accounting procedures;
8. if appropriate, an assurance of comparability of services;
9. assurances relating to fiscal control and fund accounting procedures; and
10. assurances that the Title I projects are of sufficient size, scope and quality to give reasonable promise if substantial progress toward meeting the special educational needs of the children served; are designed and implemented in consultation with teachers; provide for parental involvement; provide for the allocation of time and resources for frequent and regular coordination between Title I staff and the regular staff to ensure that both the Title I and the regular instructional programs meet the special educational needs of participating children, provide maximum coordination between Title I services and services provided to address the needs of children with disabilities or limited English proficiency; and any additional information needed by the State Education Department to ensure compliance with these assurances.

PSEN/PCEN

The annual submission of an application describing the use of such funds to the Commissioner of Education. The plan will include the number and grade span of students

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served, descriptions and objectives of each program, evaluation methods and the proposed budget. Such funds will be expended only for project activities in the school year for which the funds were appropriated.
