IDENTIFICATION AND REGISTER OF CHILDREN WITH
DISABLING CONDITIONS

The Board shall locate and identify all children with disabling conditions from birth to 21 years of age who reside in the District. A register of such children shall be maintained and revised annually by the District Committees on Special Education and Preschool Special Education. Procedures shall be implemented to assure the availability of statistical data to readily determine the status of each child with disabling conditions in the identification, location, evaluation, placement and program review process, and to determine which children are/are not currently receiving needed special education and related services. Data shall be reported by September 15 by the District Committees on Special Education and Preschool Special Education to the Board of Education. All other Commissioner's requirements under data information, data collection, and data reporting will be complied with.

The Board of Education recognizes the right of the parent to be fully informed of all information relevant to the classification or change in the classification, evaluation and educational placement of a child with a disabling condition.

The Board shall follow the procedures as outlined in the Commissioner's Regulations with regard to due process.
